Nehemiah 3:1-32

Key words in this chapter (different translations)

BUILT – 30 times REPAIRED – 31 times

REBUILT – 29 times WORKED – 24 times

1. DIVIDE THE DREAM INTO SMALLER <u>GOALS</u> AND <u>TASKS</u>

Key Phrase: "SECTION" is used 26 times (CEVJ-"a smaller part of the whole"

"The next section was built by..." Neh. 3:2, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, etc.

2. LET OTHERS SHARE OWNERSHIP OF THE DREAM

Key Phrase: "By his OWN house" used 6 times

"Jedaiah repaired the wall beside his OWN house..." Nehemiah 3:10

"Hashabiah built the wall in his OWN district." Nehemiah 3:17

"Each priest made repairs <u>near his OWN house</u>." Nehemiah 3:28

"Benjamin and Azariah repaired the wall <u>by their OWN homes</u>." <i>Nehemiah 3:23

3. ORGANIZE AROUND NATURAL RELATIONSHIPS

Nehemiah: "I posted them by families..." Nehemiah 4:13

"Eliashib and his fellow priests rebuilt the Sheep Gate." Nehemiah 3:1

"The <u>men of Jericho</u> built the next section..." Nehemiah 3:2

"The sons of Hassenaah built the Fish Gate..." Nehemiah 3:3

"Shallum and his daughters built the next section." Nehemiah 3:12

"The goldsmiths and the merchants built another section." Nehemiah 3:32

4. DEVELOP A <u>TEAM SPIRIT</u>

Key Phrase: "*NEXT to them*" is used 21 times in Neh. 3 18 different teams are mentioned

"We are <u>partners working together for God</u>..." 1 Corinthians 3:9 (TEV) **58 "one anothers" in the New Testament!**

"Two people can accomplish more than twice as much as one; because <u>they get more done by</u> <u>working together</u>. Also if one falls down, the other can help him up... And two can resist an attack that would defeat one person alone. <u>Three people is even better</u>. A rope made of three cords is hard to break." Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 (NLT/TEV) "Above all else, you must <u>live in a way that brings honor</u> to the good news about Christ... I want to know that you are <u>working together</u> and <u>striving side by side</u> to get others to believe the good news." Philippians 1:27 (CEV)

5. LOVE EVERYONE, BUT **INVEST** IN THE WILLING

Nehemiah wasn't discouraged by those who would *not* help.

"The next section of the wall was rebuilt by the men of Tekoa BUT the <u>nobles of that town</u> <u>refused to work or help</u>." Nehemiah 3:5

• WASTE NO TIME JUDGING OTHERS

"Why do you judge your brothers or sisters in Christ? And why do you think you're better than they are? Remember, each of us <u>will stand personally</u> before the judgment seat of God... Then each of us have to give <u>a personal account</u> to God. So stop judging each other!" Romans 14:10, 12-13a (NLT)

• REMEMBER GOD WILL <u>REWARD</u> WHAT I DO

"The faithless will be fully repaid for their ways, but good people will be rewarded." Proverbs 14:14

"People who are generous will themselves be blessed..." Proverbs 22:9

6. NEVER STOP SAYING THANK YOU

Paul: "I never stop <u>being grateful for you</u>, as I mention you in all my prayers." Ephesians 1:16 (CEV)

WHAT TO APPRECIATE

RECOGNIZE INDIVIDUALS BY NAME

71 individuals are named in Neh. 3

• **RECOGNIZE** <u>SPECIFIC WORK</u>

"They laid beams and put the doors, and bolts and bars in place." Nehemiah 3:6b

• **RECOGNIZE** <u>GREAT ATTITUDE</u>

"...Baruch <u>ZEALOUSLY</u> repaired another section..." Nehemiah 3:20

• **RECOGNIZE** EXTRA EFFORT

"Meremoth repaired the section by the Fish Gate... THEN he ALSO repaired ANOTHER section by the high priest's home." Nehemiah 3:4, 21
