HARMONY CREATES HAPPINESS

"You will make my JOY COMPLETE by having the same mind, by sharing the same love, by being united in spirit, and intent on one purpose." **Philippians 2:2 (NAS)**

HOW TO REDUCE CONFLICT WITH OTHERS

1. Never let my **PRIDE** be my guide.

"Don't do anything from selfish ambition or from vain conceit." Philippians 2:3a

* Selfish Ambition: IT'S ALL ABOUT ME.

"Wherever there's jealousy or <u>selfish ambition</u>, you will find <u>confusion</u> and <u>every other kind of evil</u>."

James 3:16

"Our <u>self-indulgent nature</u> shows itself... in conflict, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, causing divisions among people, and the feeling that everyone is wrong except those in your own little group." **Galatians 5:19-21**

* Vain Conceit: I'M ALWAYS RIGHT.

(LB) "Don't live to make a good impression on others."

(TEV) "Don't do anything from a cheap desire to boast."

2. Be Humble or I 11 Stumble.

"Instead, be humble and give more honor to others than to yourself." Philippians 2:3b

"God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." James 4:6

3. Learn the lost art of **PAYING ATTENTION**.

"Don't be interested only in your own life, but be interested in what concerns others too." Philippians 2:4

Jesus: "If you want to be my disciple, you must deny yourself, take up your cross every day, and follow me." Luke 9:23

4. Ask What Would Jesus Do!

"Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus." Philippians 2:5

ACTING LIKE JESUS MEANS...
